From the Pastor's Desk:


I would hope that everyone at this point has at least heard about the Hamilton Diocese "One Heart, One Soul" campaign to raise \$35 million. Our parish will begin our active participation in this campaign early in 2020. I suspect that it is in fact the purpose of this campaign which is not all that clear to many people.

The campaign finds its roots in the pastoral guidance Pope Francis offered the Church when he exhorted the parishes of the world to engage in self-renewal, and to constantly adapt so as to meet the ever-changing needs in our world today (Pope Francis, Evangelii Gaudium, 28). Our local bishop, Bishop Crosby, picked up this challenge from our Holy Father when he said: "A Diocese cannot thrive without thriving parishes. In the spirit of Pope Francis' call for parish renewal, the \$35 million One Heart, One Soul campaign is first and foremost about the renewal and transformation of parishes in the Diocese of Hamilton."

With this in mind the campaign has a three-fold purpose. One, each parish will dream about the future, a future where the local parish will be healthy and vibrant, and to use funds raised to make those dreams a reality. Two, to offer support to those parishes that are not able to raise the funds necessary to function in a healthy and vibrant way. Three, to support Diocese-wide shared ministries such as campus ministry and hospital ministry.

Each parish, ours included, will be able to keep 75% of all funds raised to be used here at Saint Francis. More information will follow in the coming weeks.
