St. Francis of Assisi has a mandatory rule that children be enrolled and take the correspondence courses for grade 2—first Eucharist and grade 7 Confirmation if your child is planning on receiving these sacraments. Due to increased costs, each course is now \$60.00 for each child, \$80.00 to register 2 children and \$150.00 to register 3 or more. Please contact our parish office if these costs create problems.
