St. Francis Ministry Spotlight

Position Description

In order to ensure the safety of all vulnerable people to whom we minister and to safeguard the integrity of our volunteers and the parish, members of the volunteer screening committee assist the pastor and Parish Volunteer Screening Coordinator in implementing the Diocesan Volunteer Screening Manual and Volunteer Guidelines at St. Francis. Some of the responsibilities of this role include: initiating the screening process when a new joins a ministry, ensure that each low or high level applicant completes a "Volunteer Information Form" and that that low risk volunteers are registered in the parish or complete the "Volunteer Information Form", schedule, conduct and document interviews for high risk volunteers, and contact references when required.

A Message from our Screening Committee Coordinator:

"In the Diocese of Hamilton, many volunteers serve in positions of trust and assist with essential services to Parishioners and the community at large. These volunteers are a valued and indispensable aspect of many ministries within the parish.

The screening of potential volunteers helps to create and maintain a safe environment for all those involved, including the volunteers themselves. This screening process is mandated by the Diocese and is essential to the operation of the many ministries that enrich the lives of our parishioners.

Catechetical Correspondence Courses

For parents of children who attend public school, the Diocese of Hamilton offers the Catechetical Correspondence courses from kindergarten to secondary school. St. Francis of Assisi has a mandatory rule that children be enrolled and take the correspondence courses for grade 2—first Eucharist and grade 7 Confirmation if your child is planning on receiving these sacraments. We encourage families to take part in all the courses if they can. Due to increased costs, each course is now \$60.00 for each child, \$80.00 to register 2 children and \$150.00 to register 3 or more. To register, visit:
