Position Description

The altar serving ministry at St. Francis is open to youth, age 7-18 (who have received First Communion), as well as adults. These volunteers assist Father in the Sanctuary with liturgical celebrations, carry the cross in processions, hold the book for prayers, carry candles, set the altar, assist with Communion preparation, and clear the altar. They may also assist with special duties for special liturgical celebrations throughout the year, for example during the Easter Triduum.

Why I enjoy being a Youth Altar Server:

Being an altar server is not just bringing chalices and dishes back and forth from the altar; it is a privilege to do it for the Lord. God gives us many opportunities to serve others, helping us grow into better people. I feel that becoming an altar server was the best thing that I've said "yes" to.

I was really nervous when I became a server 3 years ago, but have come to realize that it was the right choice, not only for prayer, but to serve the Lord Almighty. No matter how hard it gets, facing the singing voices of the choir and the community, I always keep Jesus in my mind, as it brings a feeling of closeness in love and friendship with Him. I started to realize that this was a calling for me; to make me one with God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit, and that I'm always with Him when I am performing this unique duty. I will stay true to the Word with all my heart. I invite you to join me in this great ministry, and share this sense of joy and happiness.

Being an altar server is a way of dedicating myself to God. Although it doesn't seem like much to do, for me it is more than enough to know that I was at Mass for an hour, dressed in a white gown, ready to serve beside the priest at the altar. Bringing the cross or the candle down the aisle, in front of the priest, makes me feel important; like I am guiding or lighting the path to and from the altar. I have also gained recognition in the parish community, as they see me almost every week.

When I started 3 years ago, I was very nervous being in front of everyone, especially while holding the candle before the gospel reading, during the offertory and at the end of communion, bringing the chalice and dishes back and forth. I came to realize that it's not about how you look to the congregation, but being focussed on your role in the Mass, and respectfully completing your duties. This focus keeps your mind busy and your heart ready; away from the nervousness or anxiety. I definitely encourage you, especially if you are a younger person from this parish, to come along on this altar serving path. To have a fun and learn a disciplined experience as you serve God at the altar.


Catechesis of the Good Shepherd
